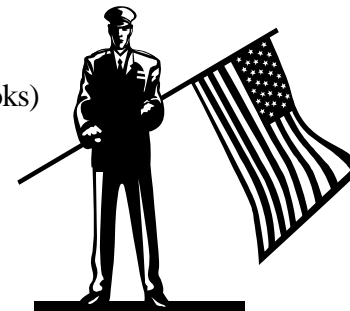
Donations for Single Soldiers
