Father's Day

This day we honor fathers and celebrate fatherhood and the influence of fathers in society. 55 of the world's countries, including the US, will be celebrating Father's Day today.

The Father's Day celebration was inaugurated in the early twentieth century to complement Mother's Day in celebrating fatherhood and male parenting. It is also celebrated to honor and commemorate our forefathers.

It is believed the first observance of Father's Day was held on June 13, 1910. It took many years to make the holiday official. A bill for national recognition of the holiday was introduced in Congress in 1913 but it wasn't until 1966 when President Lyndon Johnson issued the first presidential proclamation honoring fathers, designating the third Sunday in June as Father's Day. Six years later, the day was made a permanent national holiday when President Richard Nixon signed it into law in 1972.

It may have taken awhile to get the recognition you deserve, but we've always been proud to honor you and call you dad!
