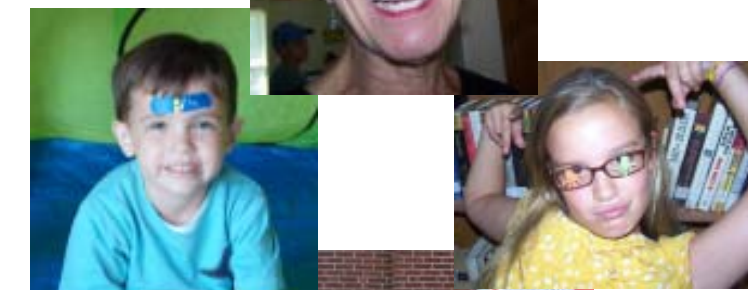


Son Rock Kids Camp Mission Bible School 2010
