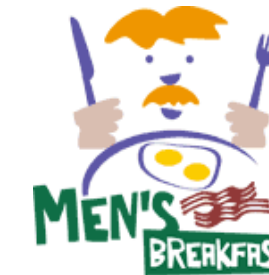

Living Last Words

On Thursday, April 1st (Maundy Thursday), the music ministry, along with a drama team, will present "The Living Last Words" by Ruth Schram. For the past few years we have heard the story of The Last Supper- this year Ruth Schram has written a new dramatic musical that traces the events of Good Friday, framed by the Last Words of Jesus Christ.

The music will be presented by members of the Chancel Choir, 2nd Mile, Men's Choir and Youth Chorale, along with an eleven piece orchestra and Earlene McLamb on keyboards and Cathy Wilson conducting. Patty Schob is the dramatic director, creating the ambience of the cross on Golgotha, and bringing together a varied cast who portray possible witnesses at Calvary; the contemptuous soldier, the crucified thief's sympathetic sibling, the scornful priest, the anguished shepherd, the grieving mother of Christ, and the heartbroken disciple, all searching for answers.

To experience Easter, we first must travel the road to the cross. Plan to make "The Living Last Words" part of your Easter journey.
